How it works...

Online

- The first day of training is done online by the learner
- The training does not have to be done all in one session – it can be done in hourly sessions

- All videos and inter-active modules must be watched in full
- Should the attendee not pass the test at the end of the online training, they will be given 1 more try only

- The trainer will let attendees know at the end of the day if they have passed or failed the course
- In order to receive a Paediatric First aid certificate, both the online training and the face to face training MUST be completed and passed in full
